



HUB OF THE JANESVILLE TRAILS SYSTEM

Janesville's paved trails are connected by one central point or 'hub', and named trails radiate out from this point like spokes on a wheel. This hub is located just north of the old railroad bridge which spans the Rock River, where Riverside Street meets the trail. All trail mileage begins from this hub.

TRAIL ETIQUETTE

ALWAYS BE CONSIDERATE OF THE OTHER TRAIL USERS

- Ride single file and be predictable: travel in a straight line.
- Yield to the slower trail user (Example: Bicyclist yield to pedestrians).
- Move well off the trail when stopped.
- Use hand signals.
- Remove litter from the trail.

WHEN PASSING OTHER TRAIL USERS

- Slow down.
- Give an audible warning, "passing on your left."
- Pass on the left.

SPECIAL NOTE

Pets are not allowed in the city parks or on the trails from May 15 - Sept. 15.

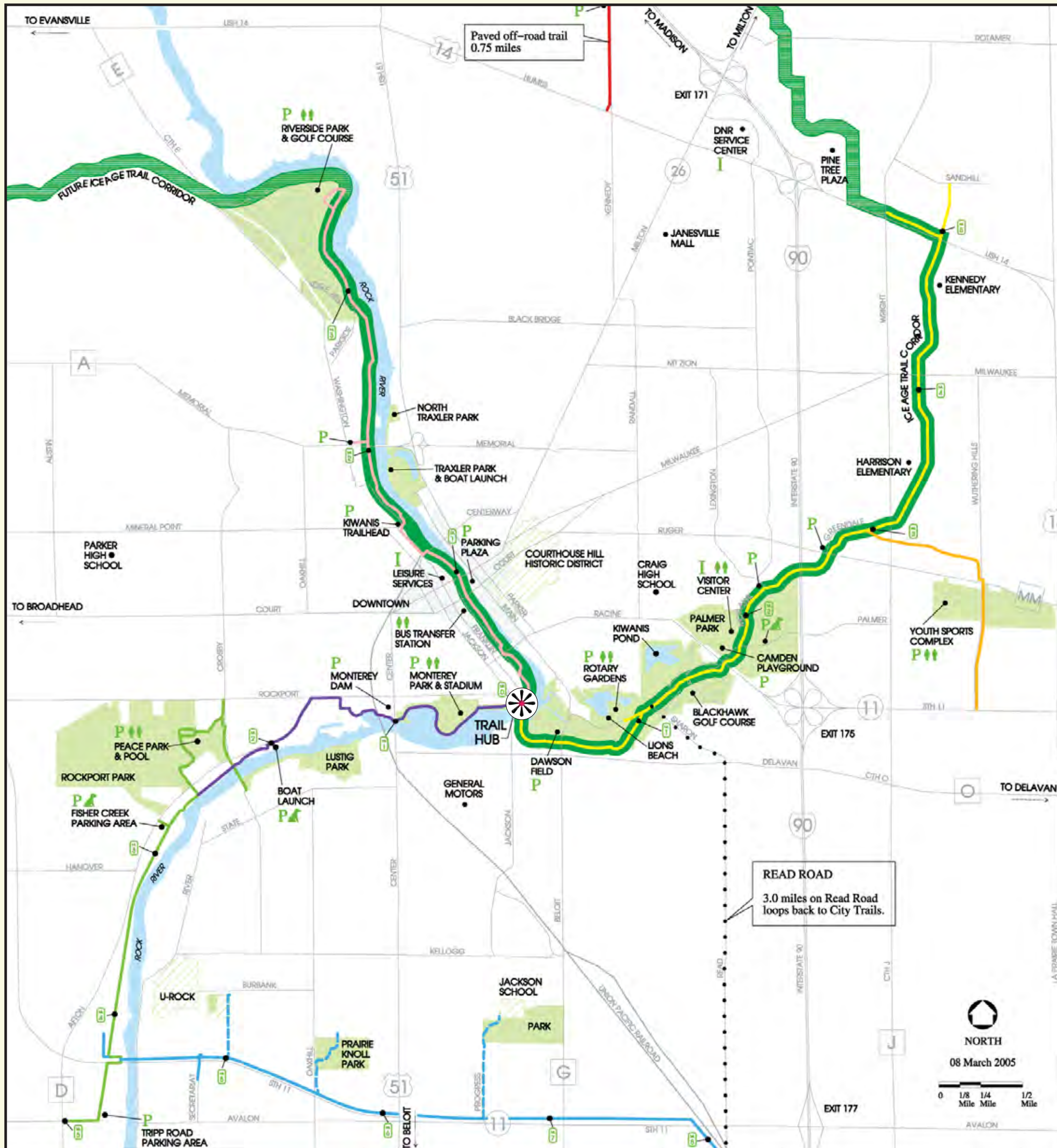

SPRING BROOK TRAIL & EAST GREEN BELT

Part of the Ice Age Trail Corridor

5.1 miles of paved trail connecting downtown Janesville to Rotary Gardens, Palmer Park, the Youth Sports Complex and Hwy 14.

KIWANIS BIKE TRAIL

Part of the Ice Age Trail Corridor

1.5 miles of paved/on street trail from Dawson Field to Centerway. 1.5 miles of paved trail connecting downtown Janesville with Riverside Park.

ROCK TRAIL

1.3 miles of paved trail from Dawson Field to the Afton Road trailhead parking lot.

PEACE TRAIL

4 miles from Peace Park playground in Rockport Park south through the Rock River Parkway and south of the Hwy 11 bypass to Tripp Road trailhead parking lot.

SOUTH CONNECTOR TRAIL

Extends 4 miles along north side of Hwy 11, from west of the Rock River and east to Read Road.

Future trail link.
