

The Impact of Trauma

Childhood trauma can have a serious impact on children's functioning. Counseling helps children develop the coping skills needed for processing and recovering from trauma they've experienced.

Trauma:

- Negatively impacts brain development
- Makes it difficult for children to manage emotions and stress
- Contributes to learning and memory problems
- Leads to difficulties in school and with peers

Trauma puts children at risk for:

- Depression
- Behavioral problems
- Self-destructive behaviors
- Relational problems
- Eating disorders
- Drug and alcohol abuse

Goal

To make contact with each and every victim and take the time to assist them with local resources. Our DVI program assists with getting restraining orders, court follow up, and helping to connect victims with counseling services.

Domestic Violence Intervention Program

The DVI program reaches out to adult and juvenile victims after a traumatic domestic violence incident in their home. In Feb of 2010, we started our DVI program after a local domestic violence homicide. This has resulted in assistance to over 1,000 local victims in our area. We work closely with both the DA's office and Victim Witness. The DVI program helps to access the situation and forward victims to the appropriate resources. DVI is currently working in collaboration with local counseling services to help victims restore a degree of normalcy.

Treatment Options For Children & Adolescents

LSS Counseling

- Able to serve all ages
- Provides individual, couples, group, and family therapy
- Insurance: Sliding fee available, accepts MA with Straight Title 19

LSS Counseling: RAYS Program

- Offers 10 free sessions within the Janesville schools or at an agreed-upon location within the community
- Able to serve ages 11-17

Mercy Health Child and Adolescent Treatment Services

- 12 –24 week day-treatment programs for children & adolescents ages 5-17.
- Extended care program for ages 5-17.

Crossroads Counseling Center

- Family group therapy for members of treatment program, day treatment program for children & adolescents with behavioral issues, individual counseling ; including EMDR, Brain Spotting, & TF-CBT treatments.
- Insurance: Most insurance, Sliding Fee

Genesis Counseling Services

- Individual counseling for children & adolescents, AODA for adults & teenagers, psychiatric assessments
- Insurance: Sliding fee available, accepts some AH HMO's

Compass Behavioral Health Clinic

- Individual counseling for children & adolescents, AODA treatment for teenagers, Healing the Wounded Child, domestic violence counseling, psychiatric assessments
- Insurance: Accepts MA with Cenpatico HMO, not currently accepting Title 19
